

## Carbon Farming



Sustainable Agriculture Project Manager Jo Wheeler is now also working with the Western Australian No-Tillage Farmers Association (WANTFA) on the Carbon Farming Extension and Outreach Project.

The project focuses on the science behind carbon sequestration and soil emissions management, and the synergies that exist between higher soil carbon content, reduced nitrous oxide emissions and farm productivity. While livestock emissions management are important, this project will focus on cropping systems.

As part of the 'Overcoming Barriers for Western Australian growers to participate in the Carbon Farming Initiative' project, Jo will be running WANTFA workshops at specific carbon farming events, popular field days and other events. Farmers, industry representatives, researchers and farm consultants are invited to come along so they can access up-to-date knowledge and information on managing greenhouse gas emissions (from livestock and soils), and increasing soil and vegetation carbon stocks.
